**Book, (author not given)** Book Title. Place of Publication: Publisher's name, Date.  
Reader's Guide. London: Lothrop, Inc., 1965.

**Work within a collection** (section written by an author other than the editor of the book) Last name, First name. "Title of Selection." Book Title. Editor's name, ed. Place of Publication: Publisher's name, Date. pages.

**Author's name (last name first). "Article title." Title of Website.  
Date of Internet publication. Date of access <URL>.**

**ONLINE WEBSITE:** Author's Last name, First Name (if available). "Article Title." Title of Website. Date or update of publication. Date of access <URL web address>.
